### REGISTRATION

[The Registration Form will be available on the web site from 1st September or email us requesting to be sent one.]

The registration fee for the conference is **£ 90**. The reduced price for registered graduate students and over 60s is £ 70. VAT is included where applicable.

Please let us know if you would like to register by **1st April 2016** at the latest, preferably using the form on the web site. Send no money: you will receive an invoice with instructions about methods of payment.

Please note: there are limited places at the conference, and registration will close earlier if it is full.

### ACCOMMODATION



Accommodation is available for the nights of **Sunday 4th September, Monday 5th September and Tuesday 6th September 2016** in the Cripps Building, where the main conference meetings are taking place. Rooms are all **single, en-suite rooms** and cost **£68** per night including breakfast (and VAT where applicable). There is no double accommodation available in College.

It might be possible to book additional days, subject to availability. Please let us know at the earliest opportunity if this is the case, giving exact dates, and we will check with the conference office. Delegates with a disability are asked to contact us with any specific requirements.

We regret that accommodation at the venue is limited and will be allocated on a first-come basis, so if you would like a room, please let us know as soon as possible using the registration form. Send no money: you will receive an invoice.

If you require a double room or wish to make your own arrangements for accommodation, you will find that there are many hotels and guesthouses in Cambridge. The nearest hotel to the conference venue is the Arundel House Hotel. September is in the busy tourist season in Cambridge and it is wise to book early

## MEALS

All meals, tea/coffee and pre-dinner drinks are included in the conference fee **except**

breakfast for non-resident delegates;

the Conference Gala Dinner on Tuesday 6th September for all delegates which is an additional cost of **£30**. Guests are welcome at the dinner, at the same rate as delegates. Places at the dinner may be booked on the conference registration form, on which you are asked to mention any dietary requirements.

## BURSARIES

Graduate students may apply for one of **four** major bursaries, which cover the cost of registration and the conference dinner, plus accommodation if required in a single room for three nights. Travel expenses are not included. These bursaries are funded by Magdalene College English Department. ## VISIT TO LITTLE GIDDING
